How do I join a Small Group? *You can sign up to join a small group on the clipboard at the Kiosk in the narthex. We will be forming groups up until Ash Wednesday. You may also call the church office or e-mail Connie Schmitz at connieschmitz@wi.rr.com.*

Is there a cost? How do I pay? *There is no cost to participate in the Bible Study. There is a recommended Devotional Book which will be available for purchase for \$5.00. On Wednesday nights we'll serve a light meal (free will offering). Proceeds will benefit one of our outreach ministries.*

Is there a deadline to sign up? *While there is not a deadline, we would appreciate it if you could sign up by Ash Wednesday (February 22) so that we can plan for materials, groups, etc.*

What happens on Wednesday evenings? *Dinner will be served from 5:30 to 6:30 p.m., Worship Service from 6:30 to 7:00, and Small Groups will meet from 7:00 to 7:30 p.m. We'll notify you of room assignments once all groups are confirmed.*

Are there any Small Groups already set up? What if I'm currently in a bible study group? *If you are currently participating in a small group such as Men's Bible Study or Women's Bible Study, you can feel free to do the Lenten Journey with your group. If Wednesday evenings, Sunday mornings or another time work better for you, please sign up for the most convenient time.*

I'm not sure I can come every week. *While it would be best for you to join us every week, we understand that work and personal schedules don't always allow for that to happen. Join us as you are able!*

I have several friends interested in joining a study. Can we form a group? *You are always welcome to form your own group. This may be a great opportunity to catch up with some church friends or get to know some new people.*

Is there childcare on Wednesdays? *There will not be childcare during the worship service, but children's activities will be offered while the adults are in Small Group time. Make it a family night....kids can come in their jammies and bring their homework!*
