Your responsibilities begin on June 1, 2010.

7th & 8th Grade Confirmation Students

Ministry	Description
Acolyte or Tech Desk	All 7th & 8th grade students will be scheduled as an Acolyte or at the Tech Desk on a rotating weekly basis. The Tech Desk involves operating the power point program during the service. In addition to acolyting on your day, you will also assist the Communion Preparation team by baking communion bread for Sunday and help with communion clean up after the service. One or more family members should assist you with your ushering duties.
Service Project	You are expected to complete <i>2 service projects each year</i> . Possible examples are Loaves & Fishes, School Service Projects, Wednesday Group Projects
Blue Sheets	All confirmation students are expected to complete 16 worship service reports (blue sheets) between June 1 and May 31 of each year. Essays will be required of all those not completing required sheets.

9th & 10th Grade Confirmation Students

Ministry	Description
Readers (Lectors) Or Tech Desk	All 9th & 10th grade students will be scheduled as Readers or at the Tech Desk on a rotating weekly basis. The Tech Desk involves operating the power point program during the service. In addition to reading that day, you will assist the Usher Team by helping usher during the worship service. One or more family members should assist you with your ushering duties.
Service Project	You are expected to complete <i>2 service projects each year</i> . Possible examples are Loaves & Fishes, School Service Projects, ASP, Youth Group Projects
Blue Sheets	All confirmation students are expected to complete 16 worship service reports (blue sheets) between June 1 and May 31 of each year. Essays will be required of all those not completing required sheets. <i>Please note: 10th graders who have not completed at least 10 blue sheets by January will automatically be assigned essays to complete.</i>
