Yellow Sheet - Due Sunday, March 14

	Invite people & RSVP for your confirmation banquet. The banquet will take place on Sunday, April 25. <i>Please turn in your reservation form and money no later than Sunday, March 14.</i>
	Choose a Bible verse as your confirmation verse. This should be a verse or passage which is meaningful to you, chosen in conversation with your parents and mentor. Write out the whole verse and verse reference on your yellow sheet
	Memorize the Bible verse you chose by Confirmation Day (May 2).
	Be fore to include your 1 to 2 paragraph explanation of why you chose the verse shown on your Yellow Sheet.

	<p>Create a 1-page (or equivalent) essay, OR a poem, sculpture, collage, video, slide show/ PowerPoint presentation, drawing, painting, photo essay, instrumental or vocal performance based on the 3 parts of the Apostle's Creed:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. I believe in GOD THE FATHER (Creator, maker, designer, divine parent, etc.) 2. GOD THE SON (Jesus, Savior, Redeemer, Teacher, Crucified One, Lord, etc.) and 3. GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT (sanctifier, inner voice, wind, inspiration, dove, coach, strength trainer, church builder, giver of faith, etc.) <p>Your project should have three parts reflecting the three persons of God in whom you believe. You will present this "I Believe in God" project to friends and family on the evening of our Confirmation Banquet.</p> <p><u>Hint</u>: You may certainly ask your mentor to help you with this project! Another <u>Hint</u>: review Luther's small catechism on the Apostle's Creed for more help.</p>
