How to get a mentor:

FIRST give careful consideration to the qualities you would like your mentor to have. It should be someone you would like to spend some time with. It should also be someone you respect as an adult Christian and you think you could learn from. He or she must also:

1. Be 18 years of age.
2. Be an active member of Our Savior's, or another ELCA Lutheran Church who lives close by. (*Exceptions may be made on an individual basis for members of other Christian churches*)
3. Be willing to be your mentor, and able to come to *all* the Second Sunday topic workshops (6-8p.m. on the 2nd Sunday of each month)
4. Be a mentor to only you during this time.
5. Not be a member of your immediate family
6. Be approved by your parents

SECOND write your prospective mentor a letter asking him or her if he or she would be willing to be your mentor. There is a sample letter enclosed along with a description of the mentor activities. You will want to send the description and the schedule with your letter. It's also a good idea that you tell the person you're writing that you will be calling them sometime in the near future to follow up with them.

THIRD, if you can't think of someone you would like to be your mentor, call Pastor Christa and she will assist you.

FINALLY once you have found someone who agrees to be your mentor, call or (even better) e-mail me and give me the name of your mentor. 367-6000 pastorchrista@oursaviorshartland.org
