

Sample letter to potential Mentor

Dear Mr. Cris Cool,

As part of my Christian Confirmation experience I will be participating in a mentor program at Our Saviors Evangelical Lutheran Church, Hartland. This program pairs a youth with an adult so the two can attend structured confirmation workshops at the church and talk together about faith in everyday life. We would meet together at the church with other students and mentors

- a) MONTHLY 6-8p.m. on the second Sunday of each month (September – May) for a themed workshop experience (required for the program)
- b) TWICE we will team with at least two other people from our church to complete 2 service projects during the year, and fill out 2 green reflection forms.
- c) AS DESIRED participate in a scheduled church youth activity with our Youth Minister, Kim Lewin.

I would very much like you to be my mentor. I consider you to be a more experienced Christian from whom I could learn a great deal. (add other qualities that you like about your mentor – like “you’ve got a good sense of humor” or “I like the way you talk to kids at church” or “you seem to be an interesting person” or “I know you like hockey and so do I”)

I am enclosing a schedule of the mentor program so you can see what the time commitment would be. I hope you will think it over and agree to be my mentor. I will call you in a couple of days to talk about it with you.
