# #TEAMTANZANIA

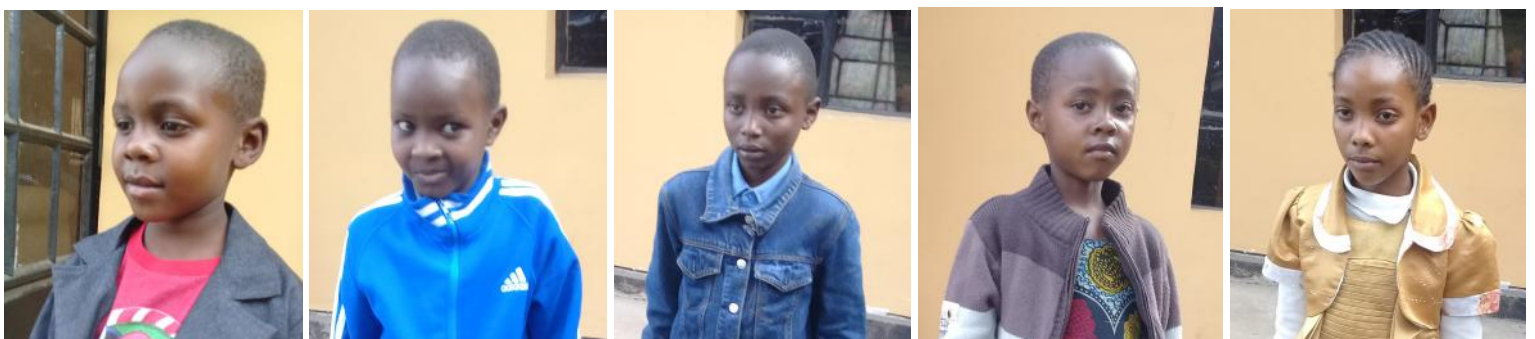
This year the Sunday School classes will be completing a service project in connection with our partner church in Tanzania. There are five children that we will be sponsoring so that they can attend school for one year. Our Sunday School students will raise money to pay for books, class instruction, and meals. In November we had a kick off rally where your child watched a video about Tanzania and heard one of our congregation members (Ann Grevenkamp) speak about her trip to Tanzania.

Each child brought home a box that they decorated with a picture of one of the children that we are sponsoring. We will be using the boxes to collect coins and then the students will bring their change into class where the teachers will collect it. Each classroom will have a fundraiser thermometer poster in their room to track how much money has been collected. When each classroom reaches the halfway point, they will receive a pajama day and once they reach their classroom goal, they will get an ice cream bar in their room. Once the Sunday School goal of \$900 is reached, the whole program will get a pizza party and movie. Kingdom Expansion will be sponsoring the ice cream bars and pizza party. The Sunday School students also received a pledge from an anonymous donor who is going to match the funds raised by the kids. Kingdom Expansion will then match the total donated to #Team Tanzania.

We are very excited for this service project and know that the students will be as well. Please ask the students what they have learned about Tanzania and share with them the joy as they work towards their goals. We have a poster combining the classrooms donations on the kiosk in the Narthex for everyone to see, please stop by and look at how well the students are doing!
