

A Pastoral Message" from the ELCA Bishops on the Milwaukee Synod site on 10/09/2025:

In this pastoral letter, the bishops call on the church to stand firmly with those often marginalized or attacked — including immigrants, refugees, people of color, and LGBTQ individuals — affirming that every person bears God's image and deserves dignity. They urge Christians to resist ideologies like Christian Nationalism, which they see as corrupting the gospel by fusing it with political power. The bishops invite the church to join them in prayer, advocacy, and hospitality: to speak up for justice, to protect vulnerable communities, and to live out Christ's love boldly, even in disagreement and division.
