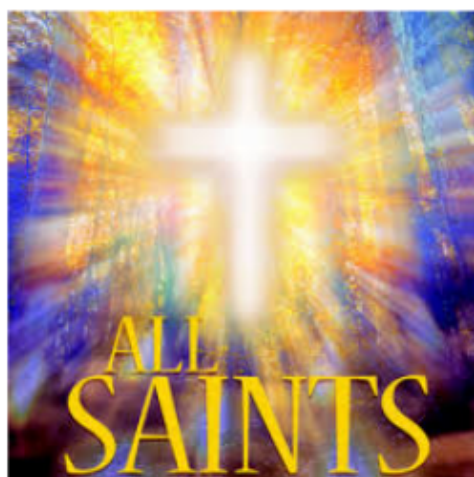

Confession and Forgiveness

Scripture

Luke 6:20-31

Jesus is the speaker in Luke 6:20-31, addressing his disciples and a crowd from a "level place" in Galilee. He delivers the Sermon on the Plain, a passage containing beatitudes (blessings) for the poor, hungry, and persecuted, and woes for the rich, full, and well-regarded.

Looking at his disciples, he said:

**“Blessed are you who are poor,
for yours is the kingdom of God.**

**Blessed are you who hunger now,
for you will be satisfied.**

**Blessed are you who weep now,
for you will laugh.**

**Blessed are you when people hate you,
when they exclude you and insult you
and reject your name as evil,
because of the Son of Man.**

**“Rejoice in that day and leap for joy, because great is your reward in
heaven. For that is how their ancestors treated the prophets.**

**“But woe to you who are rich,
for you have already received your comfort.**

**Woe to you who are well fed now,
for you will go hungry.**

**Woe to you who laugh now,
for you will mourn and weep.**

**Woe to you when everyone speaks well of you,
for that is how their ancestors treated the false prophets.**

Love for Enemies

**“But to you who are listening I say: Love your enemies, do good to those
who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat
you. If someone slaps you on one cheek, turn to them the other also. If
someone takes your coat, do not withhold your shirt from them. Give to
everyone who asks you, and if anyone takes what belongs to you, do not
demand it back. Do to others as you would have them do to you.**

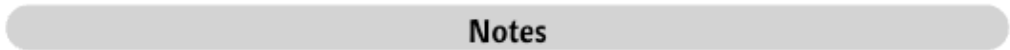
Fall Cleanup – Thank You!
