## SCRIPTURE - JOHN 1:29-42

The Lamb of God

The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him and declared, "Here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! This is he of whom I said, 'After me comes a man who ranks ahead of me because he was before me.' I myself did not know him, but I came baptizing with water for this reason, that he might be revealed to Israel." And John testified, "I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it remained on him. I myself did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain is the one who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.' And I myself have seen and have testified that this is the Chosen One."

## SCRIPTURE - JOHN 1:29-42 CONTINUED

### The First Disciples of Jesus

The next day John again was standing with two of his disciples, and as he watched Jesus walk by he exclaimed, "Look, here is the Lamb of God!" The two disciples heard him say this, and they followed Jesus. When Jesus turned and saw them following, he said to them, "What are you looking for?" They said to him, "Rabbi" (which translated means Teacher), "where are you staying?" He said to them, "Come and see." They came and saw where he was staying, and they remained with him that day. It was about four o'clock in the afternoon. One of the two who heard John speak and followed him was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. He first found his brother Simon and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which is translated Anointed). He brought Simon to Jesus, who looked at him and said, "You are Simon son of John. You are to be called Cephas" (which is translated Peter).

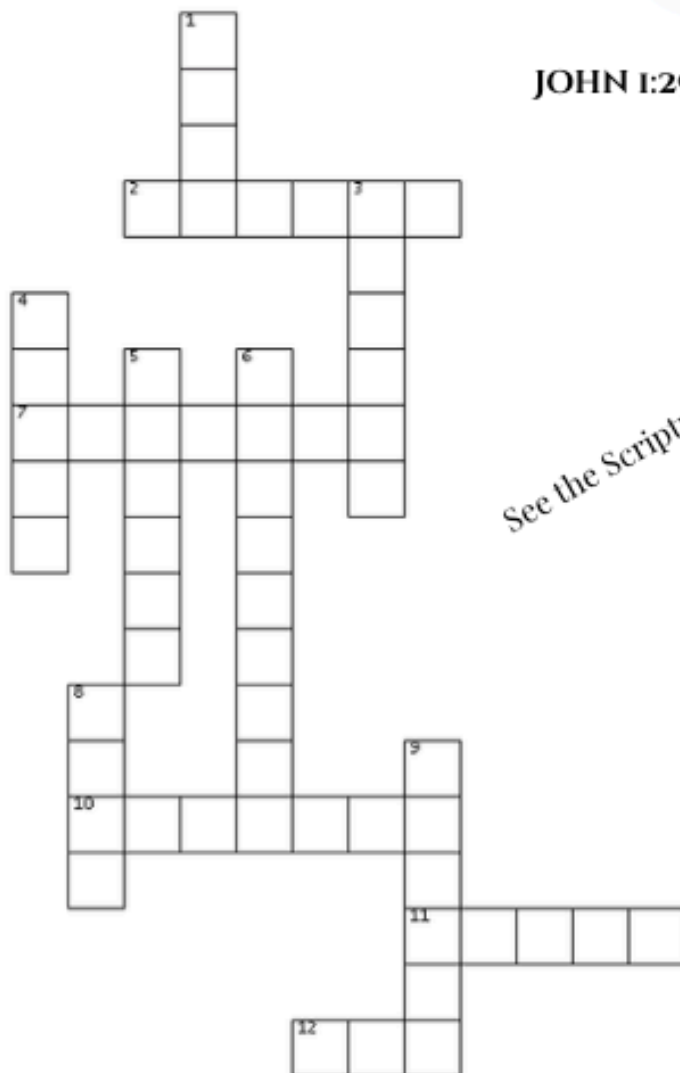

### The Lake Area Free Clinic Dental Care

After identifying a glaring lack of access to preventive and basic dental services for low-income adults in Waukesha County who had BadgerCare/Medicaid or were uninsured, LAFC opened its dental clinic in 2017. Since that time, the Clinic has delivered compassionate, high-quality dental care and support in a highly efficient environment with a dedicated staff of dental professionals.

The Clinic serves adult residents of Waukesha County and the Oconomowoc Area School District who have Medicaid or are uninsured with a household income at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level. Uninsured patients are responsible for co-pays based on income. However, no one is turned away based on an inability to pay.
