April 25th, 2026 – Honor Flight for Ron Schell 7:00 PM

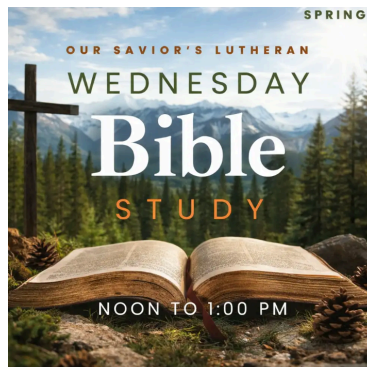
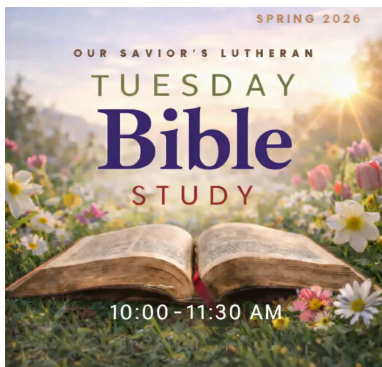

As we move forward, we recognize the need for clearer communication and greater visibility.
