*I wanted to add an important update regarding the Samsung TV display issue. I ran the scheduled updates, and that's when the issue started. Since then, all three Samsung TVs have been stuck showing the June 9 slideshow and are not receiving updated content.*

*We're also getting intermittent "not supported" messages when trying to connect or push updates. I've confirmed the IP addresses are still correct. It may be a compatibility or software issue, since MagicInfo appears to run more reliably in a Windows environment than on our Mac setup, and the timing lines up with the recent updates.*

*I'll continue troubleshooting and will update once I know more or have a fix.*
