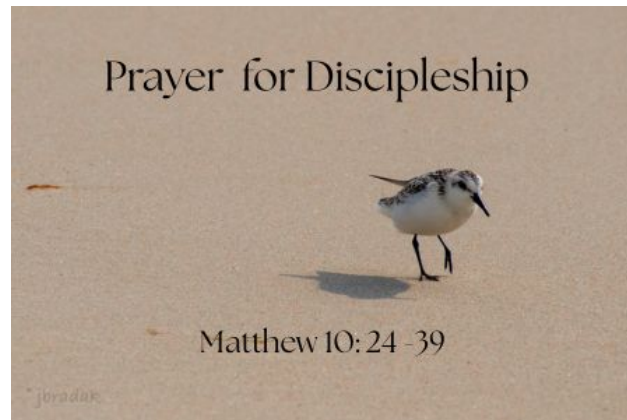

Scripture for Reflection

Matthew 10:24-39 and Jeremiah 20:7-13

God does not promise that discipleship will be easy. Both Jeremiah and Jesus acknowledge opposition, rejection, and even division. Yet neither reading ends in fear. The message is that God knows us, values us, accompanies us, and calls us to trust him enough to speak and live the gospel boldly.

Parking Lot Update

Poblocki Paving has agreed not to schedule any parking lot work between July 16–19, 2026, to avoid conflicts with the musical event on July 18. The basketball court markings will be relocated to a new area west of the garage on the south side of the lot, as the existing basketball pole will be removed. The paving company will provide a schedule for the remaining sealcoating and striping work at a later date.

Poblocki Paving will not schedule any parking lot restoration work between **July 16–19, 2026** to avoid conflicts with our musical event on Saturday, July 18.

NEW BASKETBALL COURT LOCATION
The existing basketball pole will be removed. New court markings will be painted west of the garage on the south side of the lot—approximately halfway between the garage and the gravel path to the school. This location will not interfere with parking stall lines.

NEXT STEPS
Poblocki Paving will contact us soon with a schedule for the remaining crack filling, sealcoating, and striping work.
