This summer, children in preschool through fifth grade are invited to discover God's amazing creation through Holy Moly Labs, a fun Sunday School experience at **Church of the Resurrection** during the 8:30 a.m. worship service on June 28, July 12, and July 19. Each week, students connect a Bible story with a hands-on science experiment that reinforces God's message. During the first session, children explored the story of the Wise and Foolish Builders by constructing towers and testing their strength, learning that a strong foundation in God's love and teachings helps us stand firm through life's challenges.

Students are dismissed before the readings to enjoy Bible stories, experiments, and engaging activities designed to help them see God at work in the world around them. Children, grandchildren, friends, and neighbors are all welcome to join this exciting summer adventure!




